Reporting to the Executive Director, the Client Services Manager is a member of our leadership team, responsible for managing the Client Services department ensuring a client-centred approach to service delivery. This role calls for a passionate, purpose driven, collaborative leader who is not afraid to roll up their sleeves, dive into complex challenges and contribute to a high performing team working towards a future where none of our neighbours go hungry.

JOB DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Client Service Management:

- Daily supervision, support and coaching of client service staff
- Work within program guidelines and budgets to ensure delivery of consistent, clientcentred service
- Respond to client concerns, address barriers and de-escalate conflict
- Provide leadership in the development, monitoring and evaluation of client services, engaging those with lived experience and adapting services as needed
- Lead regular department meetings, participate in staff and leadership team meetings
- Management of client service database including exporting statistics and creating reports
- Participate in meetings, workshops and networks as applicable within the community
- Contribute to a positive, inclusive service environment ensuring agency code of conduct, mission, vision and values are upheld
- Maintain up to date information on community services to assist with client navigation of community supports
- Facilitate case conferencing with fellow service providers as needed to support clients through warm transfer of service and wraparound supports
- Advocate on behalf of clients for additional supports and long term solutions to food insecurity and homelessness prevention
- Oversee the Housing department in the absence of the Housing Services Manager

Human Resource Management

- Contribute to the development and implementation of policies and procedures
- Participate in the recruitment, selection and ongoing training of new hires
- Work with Executive Director to deliver annual performance reviews
- Lead by example adhering to Project SHARE policies and procedures, and applicable legislation such as the Human Rights and Employment Standards Acts
- Coordinate the Social Service Worker student placement program, providing supervision, guidance and mentorship to placement students

- Provide leadership, guidance and support to all agency staff and volunteers as a member of the leadership team
- Oversee the agency operations in the absence of the Executive Director and Operations Manager

- At least five years 'experience delivering community-based services to vulnerable populations.
- Post-secondary education in social services or the equivalent combination of education and related experience
- Mental health and addictions training would be an asset
- Vulnerable Sector Police Clearance certificate required
